LEBANON VA MEDICAL CENTER TO DEDICATE NEW RESIDENTIAL REHABILITATION TREATMENT PROGRAM

- DETAILS:** ON TUESDAY, JULY 1, 2014 AT 11:00 A.M. LEBANON VA MEDICAL CENTER WILL DEDICATE ITS NEW VETERAN-CENTRIC RESIDENTIAL REHABILITATION AND RECOVERY CENTER. DURING THIS TIME THERE WILL BE A FORMAL RIBBON CUTTING CEREMONY AND AN OPEN HOUSE FOR THIS IMPORTANT ADDITION TO THE MEDICAL CENTER.

THIS \$7.4 MILLION DOLLAR 22,219 SQUARE FEET PROJECT WAS FUNDED AS PART OF THE VA MINOR-CONSTRUCTION MODERNIZATION EFFORTS. THIS FACILITY WILL PROVIDE STATE-OF-THE-ART, HIGH-QUALITY RESIDENTIAL REHABILITATION AND TREATMENT SERVICES FOR VETERANS WITH MENTAL HEALTH AND SUBSTANCE USE DISORDERS, MEDICAL CONCERNS AND/OR PSYCHOSOCIAL NEEDS SUCH AS HOMELESSNESS AND UNEMPLOYMENT.

THE NEW PROGRAM INCLUDES 43 RESIDENTIAL BEDS IN AN ENVIRONMENT THAT IS RECOVERY-FOCUSED, EVIDENCED-BASED, AND OUTCOME-DIRECTED. IT IS A VETERAN-CENTERED APPROACH TO CARE AND THE CULMINATION OF YEARS OF PLANNING. THIS INNOVATIVE AND INTENSIVE PROGRAM WILL FOCUS ON PROVIDING COMPREHENSIVE CARE AND REHABILITATION SERVICES FOR ALL VETERANS, MALE AND FEMALE, OF EVERY GENERATION.
