Rainbow Learning Center Reviewed by the VA National Child Care Program Team

Robert W. Callahan Jr., Lebanon VA Medical Center Director, is pleased to announce the Rainbow Learning Center (RLC), located on the campus of the VA Medical Center in Lebanon and managed by Hildebrandt Learning Centers (HLC), LLC, participated in a Veterans Health Administration National Child Care site evaluation. This evaluation was conducted by staff from the Department of Veterans Affairs located in Washington, DC. The findings from the evaluation were that the center was in compliance with the rigorous criteria established by the agency. RLC was awarded high rating scores in all categories included in the evaluation.

RLC offers programs for children from infant (6 weeks) through preschool. In addition the center also provides families with a summer school age program for children in the elementary grades. RLC offers excellent early childhood education and care to both community and Federal families and offers a discounted Federal employee rate.

RLC is the only center in Lebanon County that is accredited by the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC) and also a STAR FOUR center, the highest rating, as designated by the Pennsylvania Department of Public Welfare.

Hildebrandt Learning Centers, LLC, is based in Dallas, Pennsylvania, and manages early learning centers and school based before and after school age programs for organizations in the middle-Atlantic region of the United States. The company presently manages 40 locations and employs 900 early learning professionals. The company is listed as the eighteenth largest child care provider in the United States by Exchange magazine. Twenty-six (26) of HLC centers have achieved the pinnacle in the early learning field, accreditation by the NAEYC. In addition twenty-seven (27) HLC centers have been rated STAR FOUR by the Keystone Stars Quality Initiative Program, their highest rating.
